Principal's Report

Introduction

St. Thomas College of Teacher Education is committed to providing motivated students the opportunity to transform their lives through personalized and high quality learning environments. It prepares the learner to continue learning throughout their lives and to act ethically and responsibly in a changing world. For the past ten years, it has been a centre of talented faculty, staff and students who share a common desire to pursue excellence in every sphere of life. It has in fact become the first preference for many parents and students as it has a vision and mission of building a generation of excellent teachers fired with a spirit of service and values and it stands at the height of brilliant performance and remarkable achievements in academic and co-curricular domains.

The 9th academic year of B.Ed. Programme commenced on 28th October, 2013. The occasion solemnly began with a prayer service seeking the blessings of God in all its endeavours throughout the new academic year. The 6th batch of M.Ed. Programme started on 26th June, 2013. Generally we begin the academic activities of each day with the morning assembly at 9.40 am and we end the classes at 3.50 pm.

Strength of the College

Hundred students in the optionals viz., English, Mathematics, Physical science, Natural science and Social science were admitted to B.Ed. Programme as per the rules and regulations of Mahatma Gandhi University, Kottayam. Out of the 100 we have 80 girls and 20 boys. The strength of M.Ed. Programme 2013-2014 was 35 with 30 girls and 5 boys, and the strength of the new batch of M.Ed. Programme 2014-15 is 35 with 26 girls and 9 boys.

It is a pleasure to announce that the college has been granted permission to begin the optionals Commerce and Malayalam for B. Ed. Programme from the academic year 2014-2015.

There are ten teaching staff and four non-teaching staff. Mr. Ronish T. John and Miss Seena Joseph left services from the college. Mr. Darvin V. J. joined the teaching staff on 1st November, 2013. Mr. Jibu Joseph took over the librarianship from Mrs. Leema Jacob on 16th December, 2013. Dr. Shimna Paul re-joined duty on 1st January,

2014. Mrs. Monisha Maria George took over the librarianship from Mr. Jibu Joseph on 22ndSeptember, 2014. In a very special way, the college is greatly proud of Dr. Pushpamma C. Vadakkel and Dr. Shimna Paul who were awarded Ph. D this year and have brought honour to the college.

Tests and Examinations

The First and Second Semester M.Ed. Degree University Examinations for the year 2013-2014 began on 2nd November, 2013 and 26th May, 2014 respectively. The First Semester B.Ed. Degree University Examination for the academic year 2013-2014 commenced on 9th May 2014. B.Ed. Practical Examination was conducted on 6th and 7th October 2014. Second Semester B.Ed. Model Exams will begin on 13th October, 2014, and the University Examinations are scheduled to begin on 27th October, 2014.

Results

Out of the 65 students who appeared for the B.Ed. degree examination conducted in October, 2013, the college secured 100% pass with Twenty Five A, thirty B+ and ten B.

College Union
